ELECTRONIC RECYCLING

Cascade Asset Management will ONLY accept the following electronic devices at our event:

- Laptops/Ipads/Tablets
- Keyboards/Mice/Speakers/Accessories
- Printers/Fax Machines/Desk Copiers
- Cell Phones/Portable Electronics
- Modems/Routers/Network Gear
- Televisions/Flat Screen Monitors
- Docking Stations
- Rechargeable Batteries
- DVD Players/VCR Players

The above-mentioned items are the only items accepted. There is no charge for this service.

Cascade Asset Management assures proper handling of materials. The data-bearing devices are pulled and shredded, and the rest of the casing and circuitry is disassembled and then recycled. Since 1999, Cascade has processed more than 65 million pounds of electronics for reuse or recycling.



Plastics are being recycled into consumer products such as desk accessories and camera cases.

Cascade is NAID AAA Certified (National Association for Information Destruction) and is also an e-Steward. Both of these certifications ensure that your data and the environment are well-protected!

There will be two stations for item drop-offs during this event. Rain or shine!
